Also, at this time he was playing concerts with the Fred Baker classical guitar tuition school and excelled with his classical guitar obtaining several good grades.

He really lives and breathes Country music and all aspects of it. Very few artistes can offer the vast selection of styles associated with the Country music genre, and his dedication to his craft, his down to earth outlook, his fun to be with personality and his loyalty to the public, are just a few

things which are important to him, but the most important thing to Travis is that the Country music fans throughout the UK enjoy their, and his Country music. To his credit he has performed over 2,000 gigs in nine different countries with numerous bands, has been a session musician and is also an avid songwriter.
